**PUBLIC HEARING: Amend New Shoreham Water District's Rules and Regulations
By Eliminating the Following Section:**

7.1.b. Any building/premise connecting to the public water supply for a sprinkler system as of April 12, 2005 is required to connect to the public supply for all uses and must remove all piping and appurtenance to and from any well supplies within that structure.
